Curriculum Information

English

In Writing, we will be covering the following text types: scary narrative, non-chronological report and poetry. In reading, we will look at the following texts: Meet Me at the Steelmen, A Christmas Carol and Rosa Parks.

Maths

In maths, we will be covering addition and subtraction of 4-digit numbers, finding the perimeter of a shape & multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. We will continue to work on the 4 operations in arithmetic sessions, with a strong focus on times tables to ensure children are prepared for the multiplication check in June.

Science

In Science, we will be looking at sound, including how it is produced, patterns between the object producing the sound and the pitch produced & how sound travels to the ear. We will be completing a variety of investigations and recording our findings.

Humanities

In Geography, we will be focusing on Italy. We will look at the geographical features of Italy and compare them to the UK.

Art / Design Technology

In DT, we will be creating structures, such as bridges. We will look at how to strengthen a structure so that it can take weight across it. We will also be cooking pizzas.

PE

In PE, we will continue with our Friday swimming sessions. We will also be focusing on dance by creating our own dances based on Roman soldiers and gladiators.

Computing

In Computing, we will use Purple Mash to focus on online safety.

Other

In Music, we will continue to learn to play the recorder. We will also be singing songs. In Languages, we will be building on the vocabulary learnt in Year 3. We will be learning new words and phrases, focusing on the pronunciation. In PSHE, we will be finding out about democracy. We will also focus on how to be a good friend for Friendship Week.
