



What I should already know

- **Deciduous** plants drop their leaves once a year.
- **Evergreen** plants do not drop their leaves and stay green all year.
- Flowering plants have leaves, roots, a stem and a flower.



What do plants need to grow?




Vocabulary

seeds	The part of a plant from which a new plant grows
roots	Holds the plant to the ground and absorbs water and nutrients.
leaves	Uses light, air and water to make food for a plant
flower	Produces seeds
stem	Transports water and nutrients to different parts of a plant
germinate	Development of a plant from a seed
bud	Growth on a plant that develops into a leaf, flower, or shoot.
nutrients	Provides nourishment essential for the maintenance of life and for growth of the plant.
temperature	How hot or cold something is.

Growth from seeds/bulbs into mature plants

Bean Plant Life Cycle



- Plants begin life from a **seed** or a **bulb**
- To **germinate**, seeds need warmth, **oxygen** and **water**.
- **Seeds** and **bulbs** need water to grow but **do not** need light because they have a store of food inside them.
