Key Facts



Autumn

The weather starts to cool and leaves begin to fall from trees.

Many fruits and vegetables are picked and harvested.

Takes place between September and November.



Winter

The weather cools to its coldest temperature.

There is more rain and sometimes snow.

The trees are bare and many plants die - their seeds do not.

Some animals hibernate through the cold months of December, February, and part of March.



Spring

Starting towards the end of March and finishing towards the end of June.

Animals come out of hibernation as the weather starts to get warmer.

New plants start to grow and leaves appear on trees.

Birds build nests and lambs are born.



Summer

The hottest of the seasons when plants and flowers are in full bloom.

Butterflies emerge from their cocoons and baby birds leave nests that were made in Spring.

Starts at the end of June and finishes in September.
