Key Knowledge

Harder pencils produce lighter marks.

Softer pencils make darker marks.

A **H** pencil is hard and produces a lighter mark on paper.

A **B** pencil is soft and leaves a darker mark on a paper.

Charcoal is a black crumbly drawing material made of carbon and often used for sketching.

Crosshatching is a technique used add shade to a picture

Draw	Making lines on paper
Sketch	A rough drawing
Design	A plan or pattern
Create	Make something
Texture	Surface of something. E.g smooth, rough etc.
Pattern	A decorative design
Foreground	Part of the picture nearest to the front. Can appear larger.
Background	Part of the picture furthest from the viewer.
Focal point	The area of a painting/drawing where the viewer's eyes are drawn.
Smudge	A way to add shade in a picture by rubbing with your finger or a cotton wool.
