## **Topic: Henry Rousseau**

## What I should already know

## **Key Knowledge**

**Henri Rousseau** was born in France, he never had any art lessons and started painting when he was older. Although he never visited the jungle, he painted jungle scenes based on his house plants and wild- flowers. His art was sometimes described as being 'naive' or 'child like'

A scene is made up out of the **background** (furthest away), the **foreground** (closest) and the middle ground. Objects in the background will appear smaller, while objects in the foreground will appear larger.



Artwork can be **layered** by placing one colour over another to create **texture** and subtle colour shifts or by placing objects in front of another.

Different **media** and techniques will create different effects/emotions. Artists use a variety of techniques when they are painting to create feelings and emotions from their artwork.
