Curriculum Information



Communication and Language

Children are encouraged to talk in full sentences, answer questions and talk in detail about their responses. They will be able to follow a story without pictures or prompts, discuss what they have heard and make predictions about what may happen next.

Physical Development

In PE we will be focusing on our ball control skills, balancing and passing it in different ways around our bodies, learning to catch and throw with a partner and in a small group.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In Circle Time children will be working on developing a positive self image, developing an awareness of their own feelings, needs and views whilst also working on being sensitive to others and their feelings.

Phonics

In Phonics we will be recapping all of the sounds we have learnt so far and learning the new pieces of code; nk, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo & oo.

Literacy

In Literacy these are the texts we will be looking at over the half term: Lost in the Toy Museum, Dogger, The Boys & The Girls. We will also use Talk4Writing to recall The Three Billy Goats Gruff and work towards writing our own stories.

Maths

In Maths we will be recapping and consolidating; odd & even numbers, doubling, addition & subtraction, number bonds to 5. We will look in detail at numbers to 15 and learn number bonds to 10.

Understanding the World

In Understanding the World we will be looking at life in the past, which includes our

trip to Abbey House Museum. We will look at timelines of our own lives and discuss changes over time. We will also look at trees, their features and life cycles.

Expressive Arts and Design

In Expressive Arts and Design we will be exploring different mediums of art including the use of collage, painting, designing, observation drawings and creating different textures. We will continue to build a repertoire of nursery rhymes and learn some new songs, introducing playing musical instruments to the beat.
