Curriculum Information

English

In English, we will be writing our own narratives based on a Greek myth. We will also write a setting description about life in Ancient Greece and create persuasive letters to Zeus.

Maths

In Maths, we will continue to revise our knowledge and understanding of the four operations and practise our rapid recall of times tables facts. We will also be learning about mass and capacity and become more familiar with how to use scales to read measurements.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will learn about the importance of nutrition and how humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

Humanities

In History, we will be learning about Ancient Greece. We will find out who the Ancient Greeks were, where they lived and what life was like for them at the time. We will also consider the impact that the Ancient Greeks have had upon us and how they are still remembered today.

Art / Design Technology

In Art, we will be developing our understanding of sculpture and how it can be created using examples of different materials. We will learn about the Greek sculptor called Polykleitos and we will experiment with wire techniques to create our own examples of 3D sculptures.

PE

In indoor PE, we will be learning about dance. We will practise and put together a performance using facial expressions and props. In outdoor PE, we will be learning how to play badminton. We will learn about soft and hard hits and how to return a shuttle from different areas.

Computing

In Computing, we will start by learning about touch typing. We will then learn about how emails are used as a method of communication, and we will develop our understanding of how to open and respond to an email and how to use these safely.

Other

In music, we will continue to learn to play the recorder. In Spanish, we will re-visit our knowledge of counting to 10 and build upon this to count to 20. We will also learn about basic greetings, days of the week and months of the year. In Religious Education, we will be learning about the idea of leadership and the characteristics that leaders have. We will learn about important leaders for different faiths, why they are inspirational and how they teach key elements of their faith through stories. In PSHE, we will learn about how to work cooperatively with others. We will also learn about mental health and wellbeing. In this unit, we will discuss strengths and challenges, how to deal with put downs and learn about positive ways to deal with setbacks.
